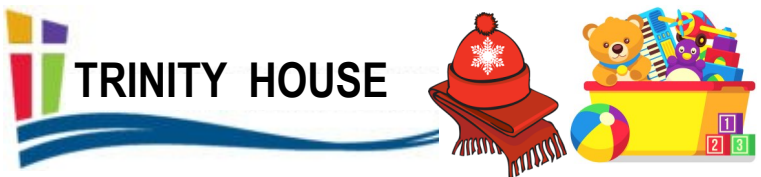


Join us Tuesday, October 26th at 6pm for a special Church Council meeting. We will be discussing the Charge Conference business items.
