We're asking for snack donations. There is a list in the foyer, or you can go to sign up genius at <https://tinyurl.com/VBS-2022-SignUp>.

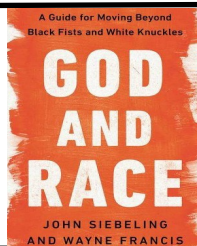

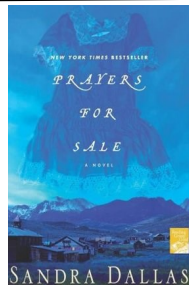


Favorite Hymn Survey

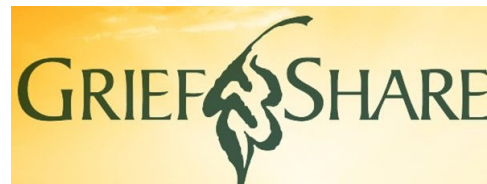
