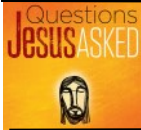

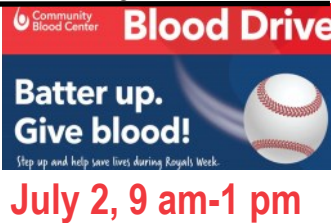


Please pray for our youth as they head to South Dakota to work with Solar Oven Partners. They leave on Monday and return on Friday.
