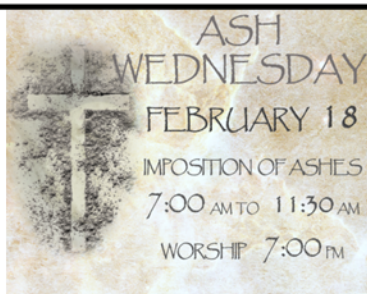
RESCHEDULED!
