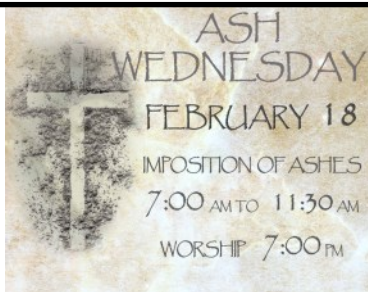
We have prizes for best chili and best dessert
